



NORTHBAY TENNIS RULES

1. Only a Member in good standing of the Northbay Homeowners Association and up to three guests may use the tennis courts at any one time.

a. The term "good standing" for the purpose of these rules is defined as being current with all financial or other obligations due to the Northbay Homeowners Association at the time the reservations are made and at the time the courts are used.

b. The term "Member" includes the Member and his or her immediate family.

2. All courts may be reserved in advance by noting so at the appropriate tennis court.

3. A Member in good standing may arrange for private tennis lessons at the courts and for up to three guests. However, a guest may not use the courts for such lessons more than six times during any one calendar year. The lessons may not exceed one hour in length and may only be conducted every seven days.

4. Members and guests are urged to familiarize themselves with the rules of tennis etiquette.

5. Guests must be personally escorted at all times to the courts and the Member must be present at all times. The Member is responsible for the behavior of his or her guests.

6. Loud or quarrelsome conduct or profanity is prohibited.

7. No person shall play on the tennis courts, except in proper tennis attire, including shirts, shorts, dresses, and tennis shoes.

8. The tennis courts and tennis court area should be used for tennis or spectating only and not for bicycles, skateboards, scooters, or other similar riding vehicles or other unauthorized uses.

9. The board of directors may suspend a member or a guest(s) from playing privileges for violating any of the above rules for any period of time, and habitual violators may lose his or her privileges to use the tennis courts.
